## New Data Sets Available from National Survey of Children's Health The Data Resource Center for Child and Adolescent Health has released the National Performance Measures and National Outcome Measures data findings from the combined 2017-2018 National Survey of Children's Health. All data are available through the interactive data query on <a href="childhealthdata.org">childhealthdata.org</a>. The combined 2017-2018 NSCH is the second multi-year data set since the redesign of the survey in 2016 and includes data from 52,129 children ages 0-17 years.
